

Teeny Mouse Crochet Pattern

Crochet your own Teeny Mouse from
Katie Piper's inspirational book 'All You Need'



YOU WILL NEED

Yarn: Lightweight cotton yarn

Small amount in beige, light blue,
navy blue, pink, red and yellow

Hook: 2.75mm

Notions:

Brown embroidery thread for nose

8 mm black safety eyes

Toy stuffing

Tapestry needle

Finished size: 10 cm / 4 inches tall



ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain; **BLO** = back loop only;
dc = double crochet; **dc2tog** = double
crochet 2 together; **M** = marker;
PM = place marker; **rep** = repeat;
RM = remove marker; **rnd** = round;
RS = right side; **sl st** = slip st; **sk** = skip;
sp(s) = space(s); **st(s)** = stitch(es);
yo = yarn over

SPECIAL STITCHES:

Puff St; Yo hook, insert into next st, yo
hook again and pull up a loop
(you will now have 3 loops on your
hook, rep 2 more times so you have
7 loops on your hook, yo and pull
through all 7 loops on hook, ch 1.
Magic ring; hold thread in your hand
and wrap working yarn around
forefinger to create ring, slip ring off
your finger and insert hook to pick
up first st, ch1, then work the necessary
sts for round 1 and close the
ring tightly by pulling the loose end.

NOTES:

- The pattern is worked in the amigurumi style, in a spiral without slip stitching or turning chains at the end of each rnd.
- Use a st marker or waste yarn to mark the first st of each rnd.
- The numbers at the end of row/rnd is the st count for the row/rnd.
- Unless otherwise stated 1 dc is worked in each st.

TIP:

To make the Sts look like X rather than V, hold the crochet hook with the hook pointing down rather than up, instead of wrapping the yarn over the hook, keep the yarn under the hook and pull through.

START

Cheeks (make 2)

Using pink yarn make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 8 dc into magic ring, join with sl st in first st. 8 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing the cheek to the head.

Head

Using beige yarn make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 dc into magic ring. 6 sts.

Continue to work in a spiral.

Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 dc in next st, 1 dc] 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: Dc around.

Rnd 5: 6 dc, [2 dc in next st, 1 dc] 6 times. 24 sts. PM in 3rd st of rnd to mark centre top of the head.

Rnd 6: Dc around.

Rnd 7: [2 dc in next st, 3 dc] 6 times. 30 sts.

Rnd 8-16: Dc around.

Using M on rnd 5 as a guide, make a few sts on Rnd 2 with brown embroidery thread and tapestry needle for the nose, insert eyes between Rnds 9 and 10, sew cheeks below the eyes.

Rnd 17: [Dc2tog, 3 dc] 6 times around. 24 Sts

Rnd 18: [Dc2tog, 2 dc] 6 times around. 18 Sts

Rnd 19: [Dc2tog, 1 dc] 6 times around. 12 Sts

Insert stuffing.

Rnd 20: [Dc2tog] 6 times around. 6 Sts

Fasten off. Use yarn tail to close the hole at the back of the head.

Ears (make 2)

Using beige yarn make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 dc into magic ring. 6 sts.

Continue to work in a spiral.

Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: [2 dc in next st, 1 dc] 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: [2 dc in next st, 2 dc] 6 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 5-8: Dc around.

Rnd 9: [Dc2tog, 2 dc] 6 times around. 18 Sts

Rnd 10: Dc around.

Rnd 11: [Dc2tog, 1 dc] 6 times around, join with sl st in first st. 12 Sts

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing the ear to the head.

Using pink yarn and a tapestry needle embroider a few sts to the inner ear using the picture as a guide.

First Leg

Using beige yarn make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 dc into magic ring. 6 sts.

Continue to work in a spiral.

Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st, 1 dc] 3 times. 9 sts.

Rnd 3: Dc around.

Change to red yarn.

Rnd 4: 2 dc in next st, Dc around. 10 sts

Rnd 5: Dc around.

Rnd 6: 2 dc in next st, Dc around*, PM in first st of round. 11 sts

Fasten off.

Second Leg

Work as for First Leg to *, do not fasten off, continue to Body.

Body

Join legs as follows;

Rnd 1: Dc around second leg, Ch 1, Dc around first leg starting in marked st. 22 dc, 1 ch.

Continue to work in a spiral.

Rnd 2: 1 dc in ch, 11 dc, 1 dc in opposite side of ch, 11 dc. 24 sts.

Rnd 3-4: Dc around.

Rnd 5: [2 dc in next st, 7 dc] 3 times. 27 sts

Rnd 6-8: Dc around.

Change to beige yarn.

Rnd 9: Dc around in BLO.

Rnd 10: [dc2tog , 7 dc] 3 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 11: Dc around.

Rnd 12:[dc2tog , 6 dc] 3 times. 21 sts.

Rnd 13: Dc around.

Rnd 14: [dc2tog , 5 dc] 3 times, join with sl st in first st. 18 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing the neck to the head.

Arms (make 2)

Using beige yarn make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 dc into magic ring. 6 sts.

Continue to work in a spiral.

Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st, 1 dc] 3 times. 9 sts.

Rnd 3: Dc around.

Rnd 4: 1 puff st, Dc around.

Rnd 5-9: Dc around, join with sl st in first st.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing the arm to the body.

Tail

Using pink yarn ch 21.

Row 1: 1 sl st in second ch from hook, 7 sl st, 12 dc. 20 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail for sewing the tail to the body.

Jumper

Using light blue yarn ch 22.

Row 1 (RS): 1 dc in second chain from hook, dc across, turn. 21 st

Row 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout) [2 dc in next st, 2 dc] 7 times, turn. 28 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, [2 dc in next st, 3 dc] 7 times, turn. 35 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, [2 dc in next st, 4 dc] 7 times, turn. 42 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, 5 dc ch 3, sk 10, 2 dc in next st, 10 dc, 2 dc in next st, ch 3, sk 10, 5 dc, turn. 30 sts.

Row 6-8: Ch 1, Dc across, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, 8 dc, 2 dc in next st, 12 dc, 2 dc in next st, 8 dc, turn. 32 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, Dc across.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew the back of the jumper closed.

Flower motif

Using red yarn make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 7 dc into magic ring, join with sl st in first dc. 7 sts.

Fasten off red.

Join yellow yarn in any st.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, (1 dc, 1 sl st) in first st, [(1 sl st, 1 dc, 1 sl st) in next st] repeat to end.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail, sew the motif to the centre of the jumper front.

Bag

Using navy blue yarn ch 7

Rnd 1: 2 dc in second ch from hook, 4 dc, 4 dc in last ch, continue along the opposite side of starting ch, 4 dc, 2 dc in same ch as first 2 dc. 16 sts.

Continue to work in a spiral.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in next st, 6 dc, [2 dc in next st] twice, 6 dc, 2 dc in last st. 20 sts.

Rnd 3-9: Dc around.

Continue to make the bag straps. If you are not at the side of the bag yet make a few more sts until you get there.

Next: ch 18, sl st into the centre of the base of the bag, ch 18, count back 10 sts from where you made the last dc, starting in that st 10 dc.

Turn.

Continue to work on these 10 sts to make the flap.

Row 1: Dc across, turn.

Finishing.

Fold each ear in half and sew to the head over Rnd 15, placing each ear in line with each eye and sewing the base of the ear closed at the same time.

Stuff the body and legs, sew the neck to the head.

Lightly stuff the arms and sew one arm to each side of the body around Rnd 12 ensuring that the 'thumb' is pointing forward and sewing the top of the arm closed at the same time.

Sew the tail to the centre back of the body around Rnd 9.

Dress the mouse with the jumper and sew the back seam together.

Weave in ends.
