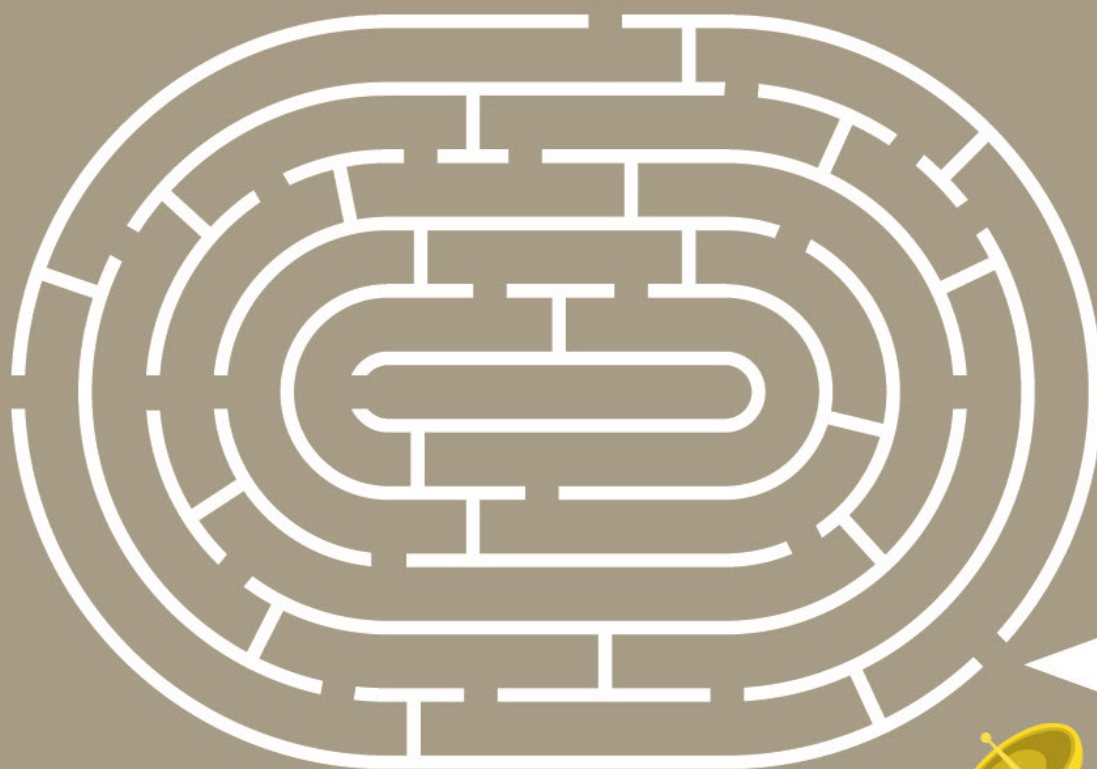

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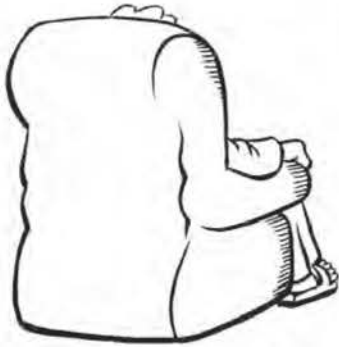
Big Boss

So, God began by making the light and the darkness, calling them day and night.



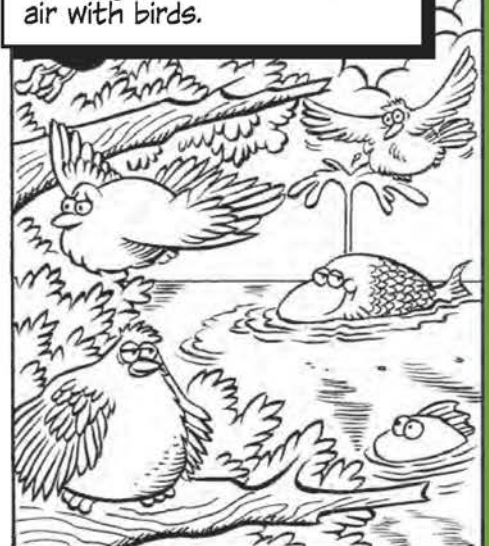
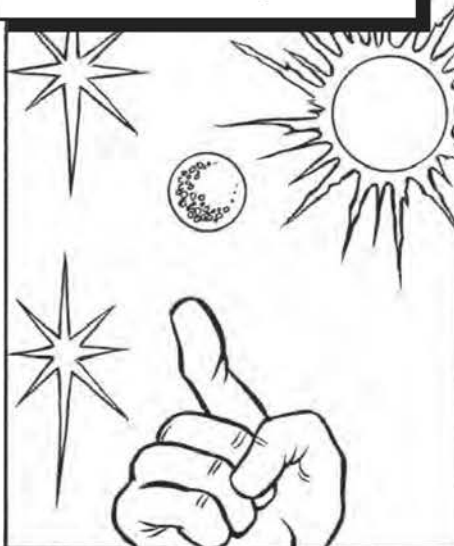

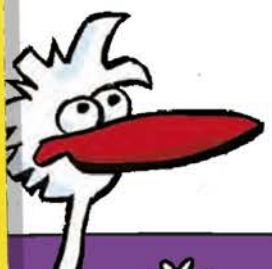

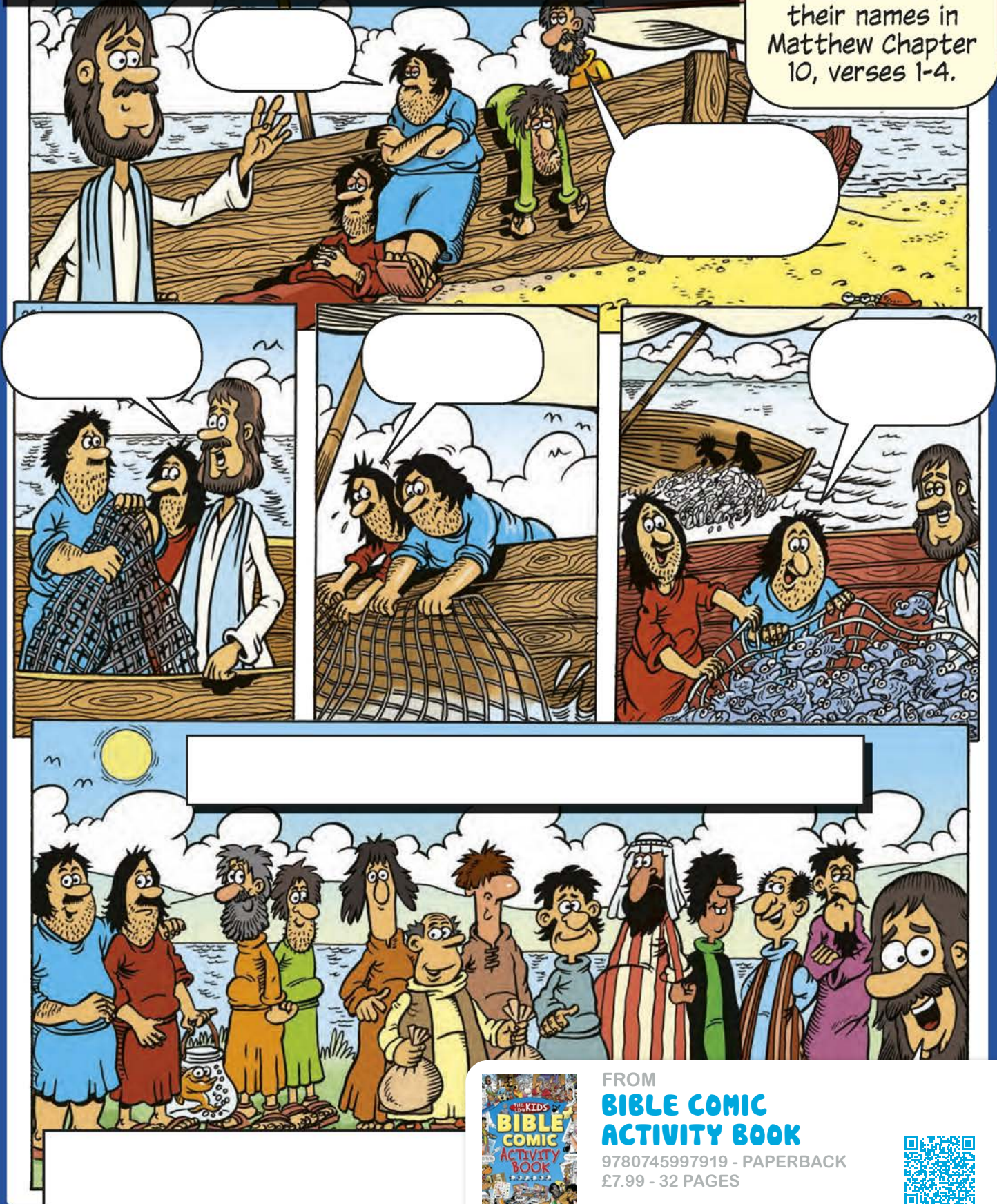

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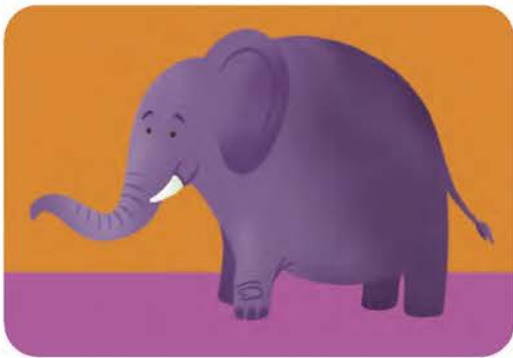
